- Prespray for traffic lanes

Directions For Use

Pretest in an inconspicuous location for color fastness and fibre stability.

Hot Water Extraction:

Use 6-12 mL of CARPET DELUXE per liter of water in the solution make up tank.

Traffic Lanes:

Mix 16 oz (472.5 ml) of Carpet Deluxe into 1 gal (3.78 L) of warm to hot water (Dilution 1:8). For best results: Pile lift or vacuum carpet prior to cleaning. Spray diluted Carpet Deluxe carpet at the rate of 800-1000 square feet per 4L of product. Agitate presprayed area using a carpet groomer. Allow 15 minutes dwell time, then rinse in conjunction with hot water extraction.

NOTE: Do not mix with any other product.

CAUTION: Carpet Deluxe is not designed for use on 5th generation fibres.
