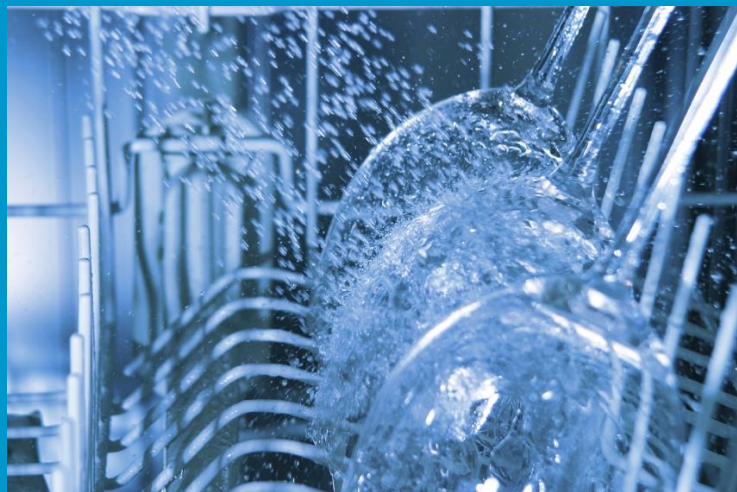

Description

ECO DRY is a premium liquid rinse aid designed for use in all types of commercial automatic dishwashers. Its unique formula provides good sheeting action and low foaming in both low and high temperature machines. ECO DRY will contribute to a significant reduction in drying times as well as the virtual elimination of spotting, streaking, and filming. As a result, glassware and utensils will be left exceptionally clean and sparkling. This product is designed to perform exceptionally in both soft and hard water conditions as well as in waters of high solids. Finally, ECO DRY contains a unique additive to aid in the inhibition of dishwasher scale build up and to protect metal components of the machine.

Directions for Use

ECO DRY should be injected into the final rinse cycle of the dishwasher or glasswasher. For optimal results operating temperature should be between 118-185 F. Typical usage levels range between 0.4-1.0 mL per liter of water (400-1000 ppm) however concentration may vary due to environmental conditions.
